At Futures Unlimited, we will continue to engage our participants remotely to provide person-centered services while they shelter in place. Our staff work with interns in achieving some of the daily goals they have set for themselves as we all practice social distancing. We take the opportunity to continually remind our interns the things they need to do at this time to protect themselves and those around them from contracting COVID-19.

COVID-19 questions answered

Q: Do vaccinated people need to wear masks?

A: Yes, when they are around unvaccinated people, or indoors.

Q: Can you get COVID-19 if you are vaccinated?

A: Yes. No vaccine is 100% effective and, though rare, fully vaccinated people can contract coronavirus. The delta variant has been proven to be very contagious and a <u>very</u> small percentage of vaccinated persons have gotten the virus.

Q: How serious are breakthrough COVID-19 cases?

A: While it's still possible for those who receive the vaccine to contract COVID-19, it's important to remember that those numbers are low. More importantly, the number of breakthrough cases that result in serious illnesses, hospitalizations or death are extremely low.

Q: Can you spread COVID-19 if

you are vaccinated? A: Yes. Fully vaccinated people who get a Covid-19 breakthrough infection can transmit the virus.

Q: Does the vaccine prevent spread of COVID-19?

A: YES! Getting vaccinated prevents severe illness, hospitalization, and death; it also helps reduce the spread of the virus in communities. Unvaccinated individuals should get vaccinated and continue masking until they are fully vaccinated.

Updated CDC guidelines

You are advised to stay home if you are sick and limit close contact with people who are sick. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth. Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. If you do not have a tissue, use your sleeve (not your hands). Use face masks if you have to go outside.
